Volunteer Luncheon

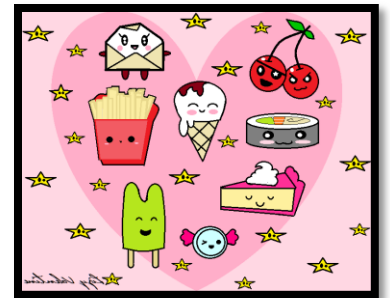
